- ❖ **Statement of Purpose:** Describe your dissertation research and explain how it advances our understanding of American politics. It should provide a timetable for completion of your dissertation and a budget for research expenses. The statement of purpose, not including the timetable or the budget, should be 1,500 words or less.
- ❖ **One Letter of Recommendation from your Dissertation Advisor:** You can either include a sealed original letter of recommendation with the application materials or have your letter writer send your letter of recommendation directly to Terri Bimes (bimes@berkeley.edu)
- ❖ *Note: If a student proposes to collect private, potentially sensitive, data about identifiable individuals, then approval from the UC Berkeley Committee for Protection of Human Subjects will be required before the grant can be disbursed.*
